Mission Statement

EPSC gives families the opportunity to pursue high level swimming close to home in a supportive, but challenging environment as well as creating opportunities for newer swimmers to explore competitive swimming through our summer and conditioning programs. We value every swimmer as an important part of our team and do our best to help them reach their potential in the pool and out.

Team History

The SUWC Sea Snakes started in 2015 and existed until the pandemic. It restarted as a non-competitive conditioning program before becoming a full USA Swimming program in the Fall of 2023.

The team has operated under the ownership of Shepherd University until the summer of 2024. The team has transitioned to new ownership under Erica Wheatley and Tim Clayton, and is operating full time this season as Eastern Panhandle Swim Club (EPSC), while still located primarily at Shepherd.

EPSC operates within USA Swimming, which is the national governing body for swimming in the US. We compete against teams generally in the Mid-Atlantic area - with meets in Maryland, Virginia, Pennsylvania and West Virginia. Our year-end focus is on our West Virginia region State Championship Meet in Morgantown. Last year we had multiple swimmers take top 3 spots in the State and we're looking forward to more this year. We compete year round with a couple different seasons - a Short Course season (25 yard pool), a Long Course season (50 m Olympic Distance pool) and our local Mid-Atlantic Summer Swim League, where we compete against other summer teams in the county and nearby in MD and PA.

We currently have 150 swimmers on the team coming from Berkeley and Jefferson County, as well as nearby cities in Virginia and Maryland. Our coaching staff work with all levels of participants to give everyone the opportunity to pursue their goals; some are just starting out and others are competing for college scholarships. We foster not only competition and fitness, but also leadership, confidence, and respect for ourselves and others. Graduates from our swim programs will have learned to work hard to overcome challenges and apply those lessons in college, as well as in their profession and personal lives.
